Foreman wages shall be **\$1.50** more than the wage rate of the highest paid Journeyman working under his supervision.

Each employee shall be allowed ten (10) minutes before noon and ten (10) minutes at the end of the work day for personal wash up time. The cleaning of brushes, taking down scaffolding and ladders, folding drop cloths, etc... shall be done within the time constituting a work day.

Welfare: Welfare payments shall be made payable to Construction Industry Welfare Fund of Central Illinois, 43 East Springfield Ave. Champaign, IL 61820.

Pensions, F.T.I., L.M.C.I., STAR, and Administrative Dues Check-Off shall be payable on the form provided and in the manner prescribed by Painters District Council #58.

Contractors will withhold employee deferrals for 401 (k) type plan.

The following holidays shall be observed: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Fourth of July, Thanksgiving Day, the day after Thanksgiving and Christmas Day. Labor Day will be observed in all Local Unions. The above holidays shall be observed according to National Law where applicable.
