Structural, Ornamental, Reinforcing, Machinery Mover, Rigger, Machinery Erector,
Welder, Fence Erector, Sheeter

Journeyman.....		\$28.50
Foreman - not less than \$2.00 per hour more than the above listed Journeyman rates.		
General Foreman - not less than \$2.30 per hour more than the above listed Journeyman rates.


