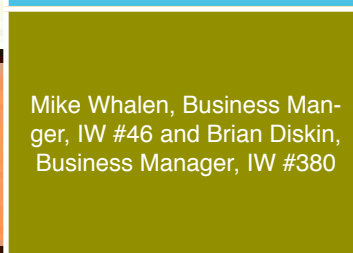

An informational seminar was held at the Decatur Conference Center on June 12, 2007 for CIB member companies in order to provide an overview of the newly enacted Iron Workers IMPACT program, which became effective in collective bargaining agreements with Iron Workers #46 (Springfield) and Iron Workers #380 (Champaign). Contributions for the IMPACT program began May 1.

IMPACT is a labor-management program designed to help union contractors become more competitive. Robert Banks, Director of the Eastern Region IMPACT office, provided attendees with an overview of the many things that IMPACT is attempting to do.

One of the main advantages of IMPACT is that it will provide a pool of drug-tested journeymen.
